

The publisher reviews all relevant materials submitted to the editorial office with the double “blind” method, with the aim of their expert evaluation.

All reviewers are recognized experts on the subject of the reviewed materials. They have publications on the subject of the reviewed article over the past three years.

An exception may be:

- Manuscripts authored by academics and corresponding members of the Academy of Sciences;
- Manuscripts specially prepared on the order of the editorial board by leading scholars and practitioners;
- Reference materials, reviews, comments, etc.

Editorial offices send a reasoned refusal to the authors of the submitted materials.

If necessary, the article should be corrected by the author as soon as possible and re-submitted to the editorial board.

All changes made by the author in the materials of the publication are verified with the comments and recommendations of reviewers.

If two independent experts appointed by the editorial board have decided not to publish the article, then the article will not be published.

Scientific results can be re-sent to the editorial board of journals only after serious revision in the form of a new article, which should be accompanied by a review received from the new reviewer.

Reviews are kept in the publishing house and in the editorial offices for 5 years.

The editorial office ensures permanent storage of the published scientific articles and giving the mandatory copies of publications, according to established order.

Materials of articles are not disclosed by reviewers without permission of the editorial board.

Information and ideas received during the review and related to possible benefits are not used for the personal purposes of the reviewer without the written consent of the author.
